



## **HALF DAY DURBAN TOWNSHIP TOUR**

Your tour starts with a visit to the KwaMuhle Museum where you will gain an understanding of the history of Apartheid in Durban. Drive through contrasting residential areas, each a reflection of the socio-economic backgrounds of their inhabitants. Start at the informal settlements of Cato Manor where you will have the opportunity to meet a family and to understand the situation that many families find themselves in while living in the townships. Continue to the formalised government housing of Chesterville a contrasting style of the 1940's with that of the post '94 housing projects.

Visit the township of Clermont where you stop at a local "shebeen" and also visit KwaDabeka, the largest migrant labour hostel in South Africa, home to some 20 000 people.

Return to your hotel in Durban.
