



SOUTH AFRICAN JOURNAL OF PSYCHOLOGY RFP: PUBLISHERS

The Psychological Society of South Africa (PsySSA) requests proposals from academic publishers for:

- 1) Publishing the quarterly *South African Journal of Psychology (SAJP)*;
- 2) Publishing the quarterly member electronic newsletter, *PsyTalk*;
- 3) Assuming other publishing and related functions as may be agreed.

Proposals should indicate the kind of marketing, sales and related support that will be provided to the *SAJP*, including the management of online editions of the *SAJP* and the electronic member newsletter, *PsyTalk*. Proposals should be submitted by 1 March 2012 to Ms Fatima Seedat <fatima@psyssa.com>, to whom queries may be directed until 1 February 2012.

Short-listed publishers will be invited to make presentations of not more than 20 minutes each on 21/22 July 2012 in Cape Town (prior to ICP 2012) to a Review Panel, which will make recommendations to the Society Executive. The successful publisher is expected to assume full responsibility for the publishing functions of the Society by 1 January 2013.
