Award for Undergraduate Teaching Excellence and/or Graduate Teaching Excellence

This prize is awarded to individuals who have sustained experience in a university requiring substantial teaching responsibilities in Psychology.

Eligibility

- ✓ At least a Master's qualification
 - ✓ No disciplinary actions against teaching record
 - ✓ Must have worked in academia for at least 5 years
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Assessment criteria

Contribution to psychology should be visible through excellent teaching record at the undergraduate and/or graduate levels.

The nomination form below should be submitted with a letter of support detailing:

- The nature of the nominee's work, which should demonstrate the following:
 - (a) Excellence in teaching - Evidence for this might include course syllabi, awards, lesson outlines, student evaluations, textbooks written, course handouts, and at least two letters of support from students.
 - (b) Student accomplishments - Evidence would include projects completed by students; papers presented and/or published work, awards and any accomplishments by students influenced by the lecturer.
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Additional documents required

- CV of the nominee
- Supporting documents such as those suggested in a) and b)

Judging body and process

- A jury will evaluate nominations.
 - Nominations close on 30 June 2017.
 - The selection will be made at least two weeks before the PsySSA Congress.
