Feminism & Psychology and the PsySSA Sexuality & Gender Division announce the inaugural prize for **best student presentation** in the field of **sexuality and gender** at the 2016 PsySSA Congress, 20-23 September 2016, Emperors Palace. The prize consists of a certificate and a year's subscription to Feminism & Psychology (besides the prestige, worth around R1 500.00). Feminism & Psychology is an international peer reviewed journal that provides a forum for debate at the interface between feminism and psychology. The journal's principal aim is to foster the development of feminist theory and practice in and beyond psychology. It publishes high-quality original research, theoretical articles, and commentaries (http://fap.sagepub.com/).

To be considered for the prize, student members of the Sexuality and Gender Division need to enter their papers for consideration by submitting an abstract for the PsySSA Congress 2016 (http://www.psyssa.com/psyssa-congress/psyssa-congress-2016/), and by sending an e-mail containing the abstract to Prof Carien Lubbe-De Beer at Idbeec@unisa.ac.za. All entries must be accompanied by entrants' student numbers, the name of the institution at which they are registered, and the degree for which they are registered. Only oral presentations are eligible for the prize. Posters and participation in round-table discussions will not be considered.

The winner will be announced at the 2016 Congress.
