Prof. Randall is a Professor in the School of Counselling and Counselling Psychology at Arizona State University in Tempe, AZ, USA. She is an internationally recognised scholar on close relationships, wherein she brings her expertise in family studies and human development to counselling psychology to address how partnered individuals cope with stress. Prof. Randall's research has been supported by over \$1 million US dollars in federal and private funding and has been widely disseminated in over 100 peer-reviewed publications, several of which are co-authored with students. Prof. Randall's work has been cited over 7,350 times (h-index = 41, i10-index = 84). A testament to Prof. Randall's contributions to the international advancement of psychology, she has served as a Fulbright Fellow (Switzerland, 2007) and Fulbright Specialist (Indonesia, 2023). She was named President-Elect of the *International Association for Relationship Research* (IARR) for the 2026-2028 term and is the recent past Editor-in-Chief of *Personal Relationships*, the flagship journal of IARR. Prof. Randall holds Fellow status in the American Psychological Association's Division 17 (Society for Counselling Psychology), Division 43 (Society for Couple and Family Psychology), and Division 52 (Society for Global Psychology). She was appointed Unisa Professor Extraordinarius in 2025.
